I was touched by the most loving and caring father that was showing the most touching signs of affection to his son: wiping Tony's saliva, standing him up for a few hours to develop a better muscle tone by holding him around the waist, feeding him through the peg tube and asking God for Tony's healing. Everyone in our Church community loved Tony and Steve and tried to help in any way they could.

Later on I have gotten involved in helping with family living arrangements, day to day operating expenses and also with medical supplies. Steven knew exactly what kind of wheelchair was needed, what type of leg brace will work the best to avoid falls. He would request the most breezing incontinence supplies in order to avoid any complications, such as rashes or sores, etc. All supplies that I have provided to this day were at no charge to Sakes.

Through all our prayers and Steven's dedication to bare his cross and care for his son, he was able to avoid infections, skin abrasions and other conditions that are very common in similar cases. We were all amazed by the amount of love and God's grace towards the Sakac family. Tony's mother neglected her son and left the ill boy in the hands of his father. Steven sacrificed his life and day to day pleasures in order to care for his son, where other's would look into a Nursing home type of setup.

Since I have first learned about Sakes family tragedy, I have been helping Tony by sending him all the necessary wound care products, I have also contacted his local medical supply company and negotiated with the owner to provide a better wheelchair in order to achieve the most comfortable positions and as much as possible avoid/ delay development of the sores, which practically unavoidable with long term bedridden patience.

As you all know, Lyme disease has no mercy, it is very persistent and debilitating illness. The fact that Tony stayed with his father for so long, no doubt, prolonged his life and gave all of us, and specially his father, the hope that things can turn around and the young men might heal. On the way from Washington DC to Nevada, Steven has met hundreds of people and heard nothing but support in his efforts.

Running a medical supplies business for over 20 years and having a personal experience with my family members and many clients in similar symptoms , I can testify that medical care in long term facilities are far less effective in comparison to a homecare which is provided by the loving family members. Latest actions taken against Mr.Sakac is clearly baseless and overreaching, these actions negate over 20 years of selfless service of his father that dedicated his personal life for the wellbeing of his only son . Sakac family has shown us all how to care for our loved ones, not to give up and obey our God.
